is a must.

Dress

Acceptable:

Casual business attire suitable for the humid tropics. Linens, cottons and loose fitting clothing are most comfortable for our school that relies on island breezes to stay cool. Dresses and skirts are fine, should be modest and near fingertip length. A modest one-piece swimsuit for school water outings is appropriate.

Unacceptable:

No spaghetti straps, cleavage bearing tops, midriff bearing/ crop tops, yoga pants/ leggings as pants (outside of school hours is fine). Two piece swimsuits for outside of school functions are fine, providing there is full rear coverage and reasonable bust coverage. Just keep in mind it's a small island, you are a representative of our school and church and will run into people at the beach.
